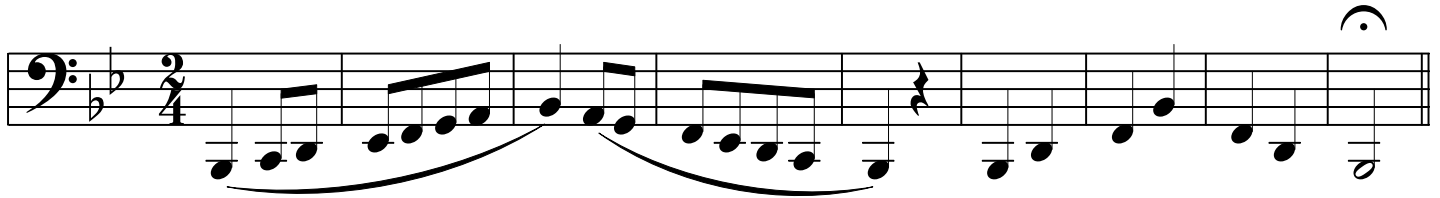

Perform your scales like this:

Example 1: Tuba, One Octave (Bb Major)



Example 2: Trombone/Euphonium, One Octave (B Major)



When you start out one octave will suffice; quarter note= 60 is a good tempo to begin with.

As you progress add octaves and speed. Eventually you will progress beyond this level:

If you have trouble remembering your key signatures:

Order of Flats: BEADGCF

Order of Sharps: FCGDAEB

Circle of Fourths/Fifths

Perform scales in order (4ths) starting in the key of the fundamental of your instrument.
